**Items to Consider for 2009 Tax Filing**

Non cash donations:  
You will need to provide the fair market value of your donation; for non-cash donations over \$500, you need to provide the date and location of your donation.

Standard deduction filers:  
remember you can also add your real estate taxes and the sales tax paid on a new car purchase.

The New Hope Credit (aka American Opportunities Credit):  
Tuition and fees credit is available of up to \$2,500 per year for each of the first four years of college. The Lifetime Learning Credit is still available after the first four years.

Home Energy Credit: for qualified expenditures in

2009 and 2010, there is a credit for 30% of costs, up to \$1,500.

"Making Work Pay" Tax Credit: This credit will be calculated on your return based on your earned income in 2009. The maximum is \$400 for eligible single filers and \$800 for eligible couples filing a joint tax return.

1099 Preparation: just a reminder that businesses are required to file Form 1099-MISC to non-employees who have been paid \$600 or more. We have the forms and can assist you in filing these.

Looking forward to 2010:  
consider rolling your regular IRA to a ROTH IRA.
